Any person aggrieved may appeal from the action of the Special Assessment Commission by filing with the City Administrator prior to the hearing a written notice of appeal stating therein the grounds upon which the appeal is based. Any person having filed such a written notice may appear before the City Commission and present reasons why the action of the Special Assessment Commission should not be confirmed.
