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systems including silos, control centers, and other ground infrastructure," said Russell Bartholomew, a Program Manager assigned to the Air Force Nuclear Weapons Center Sentinel Systems Directorate at Hill AFB, Utah. "It's an honor to start the hearings here at the Fort Berthold Reservation, given the long history between the U.S. military and Three Affiliated Tribes."

According to statements in the presentation, the proposed action of the Sentinel System installation and decommissioning of the Minuteman III missiles would have short-term adverse effects as well as short-term benefits. The proposed action

and project would cause a gain in population that would exceed the annual average. It would also place a burden on public schools, triggering the need for more capacity of the anticipated student increase. It would increase the demand on housing rental market with the influx of incoming migrating workers filling construction jobs. Those jobs would be a temporary but significant economic benefits in the employment sector for the area around the missile hub site and the laydown/staging areas.
